MOTTO: FAITH, STRUGGLE, KNOWLEDGE

1. General Discipline & Code of Conduct

- All cadets must honor and uphold the core values of the Askari Foundation: Faith, Struggle, and Knowledge.
- Strict obedience to the Principal, instructors, drill staff, and senior cadets is mandatory at all times.
- Cadets must demonstrate high standards of moral integrity, honesty, and comradeship.
- Bullying, use of abusive language, fighting, or any form of physical violence is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disciplinary action.

2. Uniform & Turnout

- Cadets must wear the prescribed AFMS uniform during academy hours, drills, and official functions. Uniforms must be impeccably clean, properly ironed, and complete.
- Hair must be neatly trimmed to the standard "Cadet Cut" at all times.
- Black uniform shoes must be highly polished.
- Wearing unauthorized accessories, jewelry, or non-regulation items with the uniform is strictly forbidden.

3. Academic & Physical Training (PT) Standards

- Active participation in both academic classes and daily Physical Training (PT) is compulsory.
- Missing classes, drills, or PT sessions without prior medical exemption from the academy medical officer is a severe offense.
- Cadets must complete all assignments on time and maintain the required academic baseline to remain in the pre-cadet track.

4. Attendance & Leave Policy

- Punctuality is the hallmark of a cadet. Cadets must report to the morning assembly and all formations exactly on time.
- Leave is only granted in cases of extreme emergency or verified medical reasons.
- All leave applications must be submitted in writing by the parents/guardians at least 3 days in advance and must be approved by the administration.
- Overstaying approved leave without immediate and valid justification will result in penalties.

5. Prohibited Items

- Mobile phones, smartwatches, tablets, and any unauthorized electronic devices are strictly banned on academy premises. Confiscated items will not be returned.
- Possession of sharp tools, weapons, unauthorized medicines, smoking materials, or prohibited substances will result in immediate expulsion.
- Possession of excessive cash (beyond the allowed pocket money limit) is not permitted.

6. Mess and Campus Etiquette

- Cadets must observe absolute silence and discipline while moving in squads between classes or facilities.
- Proper dining etiquette and table manners must be observed in the cafeteria/mess. Wastage of food is strongly discouraged.
- Cadets are responsible for the cleanliness and maintenance of academy property. Vandalism or destruction of property will result in heavy fines and punishment.

7. Violations and Disciplinary Action

- **Violation can cause penalties, fines and punishments depending on the situation.**
- Specific disciplinary measures may include:
 - Extra Drill / Extra Physical Training (PT).
 - Cancellation of weekend leave / Out-pass.
 - Official warning letters to parents.
 - Suspension or permanent rustication (expulsion) from the Askari Foundation School System for severe or repeated offenses.
